(1) 医生命科学系分科会

テーマ 臨床研究の有益性を向上させるためには何が必要か

概要

臨床研究においては、もたらし得る有益性が、研究に伴うリスクを凌駕していることが倫理的原則であり、「人を対象とする生命科学・医学系研究に関する倫理指針」においても、倫理審査委員会の責務として、倫理的観点及び科学的観点から審査することを要求している。しかし、現実には、長年にわたる科学性についての検討は極めて手薄の状況が放置されてきた。

APRIN では、2022 年度、「臨床研究有益性向上会議」を設立し、臨床研究の支援・教育に深く関わり、また臨床研究計画の実務についても豊富な経験を有する方に協力を依頼し、この問題に取り組むこととした。

まず初めに、臨床研究を計画する方、および倫理審査を行う研究者を対象に、臨床研究計画に当たるとかく生じやすい誤り、および科学的価値への打撃が大きい誤りを避けるための研究計画段階でのチェックリストの作成を開始した。

このチェックリストは、倫理審査委員会に提出する倫理性に関するチェックリストとは異なり、あくまで助言を通しての気付きの誘導が目的である。

本分科会では、有益性向上のためのチェックリストの意義と「臨床研究有益性向上会議」の議論の進捗状況をお伝えし、参加者の皆様からのご意見・ご要望をお聞きする場としたい。

テーマ 事例にみるデータ不正・検査不正の背景と公正化策

概要

APRIN 理工学系分科会では、研究のみならず企業における倫理も含めて検討している。この分科会では、近年、頻繁に発生している企業のデータ不正、検査不正などの品質不正を取り上げている。

企業におけるこれらの不正に関して「不正リスクの調査白書」の講演により現状と動向を紹介する。次の講演で、不正の背景や原因を探りその防止策を検討する。3 番目の講演で、企業における技術開発、技術管理における倫理問題について、品質不正を含めて全般的に検討する。

これら 3 件の講演に続いて総合討論を行い、企業での公正な技術開発や技術管理に向けての倫理的課題を浮き彫りにする。

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(3) 人文学・社会科学系分科会

テーマ 人文学・社会科学分野の研究業績と研究評価

概要

人文学社会科学分野において大学の部局や研究室を発行元とする紀要論文での研究発表は、学術誌での発表にはない重要な意味を持っている。紀要は機関レポジトリ等で一般に公開されている場合が多く、会員でないとアクセスできない場合がある学術誌に比べて広く共有されやすいという特徴がある。一方で、紀要には査読の体制・有無が不明瞭だったり、投稿規程が明確でなかったりといった懸念点もあり、研究機関における人事評価での扱いは様々である。また、査読審査や投稿規程がないことに起因してか、意識的にか無意識的にか、二重投稿や自己盗用といった研究不正の場となってしまうことも否定できない。

人文学社会科学分野において紀要が成果発表の場としてどのように扱われているか、研究業績としてどのように理解されているかの現実を把握し、共有することが重要であろう。この問題意識に基づき、本分科会では紀要の実態とその意義について接近する。

本テーマについてはすでに多くの議論や取り組みがある。研究の公開性や透明性といった研究公正で求められている昨今の観点も踏まえて、参加者の皆様と議論をしたい。

(4) 中等教育における研究倫理の教材作成分科会

テーマ 中等教育における「探究」と研究倫理について

概要

今年度、中等教育用の「理数探究基礎」の教科書が発刊され、中等教育の場では、授業時間を使った「探究」へのあらたな取り組みが開始されている。一方、APRIN では中等教育における研究倫理に関する教材「基礎編」および「実践編」を公開してきた。最近は中等教育の現場(課題研究・コンテスト参加等)での教材活用への関心が高まっている。こうした状況を踏まえると、生徒が学ぶべき研究倫理やその指導にあたる先生が知っておくべき研究倫理等について、中等教育の研究の実状を様々な立場から自由に議論することが有意義と考える。

今回の分科会シンポジウムでは、3名の講師の方に講演をいただき、中等教育における「探究」と研究倫理について、問題点や課題などを自由に討論する。

(5) 研究倫理教育事務担当者向け分科会

テーマ 研究力向上を目指す研究倫理教育の現状と課題

概要

平成 26 年 8 月 26 日に「研究活動における不正行為への対応等に関するガイドライン」が文部科学大臣決定され、8 年が経過した。当初、各研究機関においては、公正研究推進のために、

- ・「研究倫理教育責任者」の設置などの必要な体制整備を図り、広く研究活動に関わる者を対象に、定期的に研究倫理教育を実施
- ・規程・体制の整備及び公表等、整備を図る
- ・新たな体制等に基づく特定不正行為の告発の受付
- ・事案の調査（予備調査、本調査、認定、不服申立て、調査結果の公表等）

などに取り組まれてこられたことと思うが、文部科学省調査によると、残念ながら様々な不正行為が後を絶たないのが現状である。

本分科会では、有用な情報として、「研究倫理教育のこれまでの啓発活動と新しい教材の活用について～JST が開発した映像教材を通じて～」と題し、科学技術振興機構（JST）様よりご講演いただくこととなった。

APRIN からは、「APRIN 加入状況」、「受講コースの現状」、「受講コースの単元構成」、「既存受講コースの見直しに有用な単元毎の情報」などを皆さまに共有させていただく。また近年開発した新たな教材及び公正研究に関する冊子等を広く知っていただくため、改めてご紹介する。

研究倫理教育における各機関様の様々な課題の解決の一助となれば幸いである。

【What's Tsugaru Shamisen】

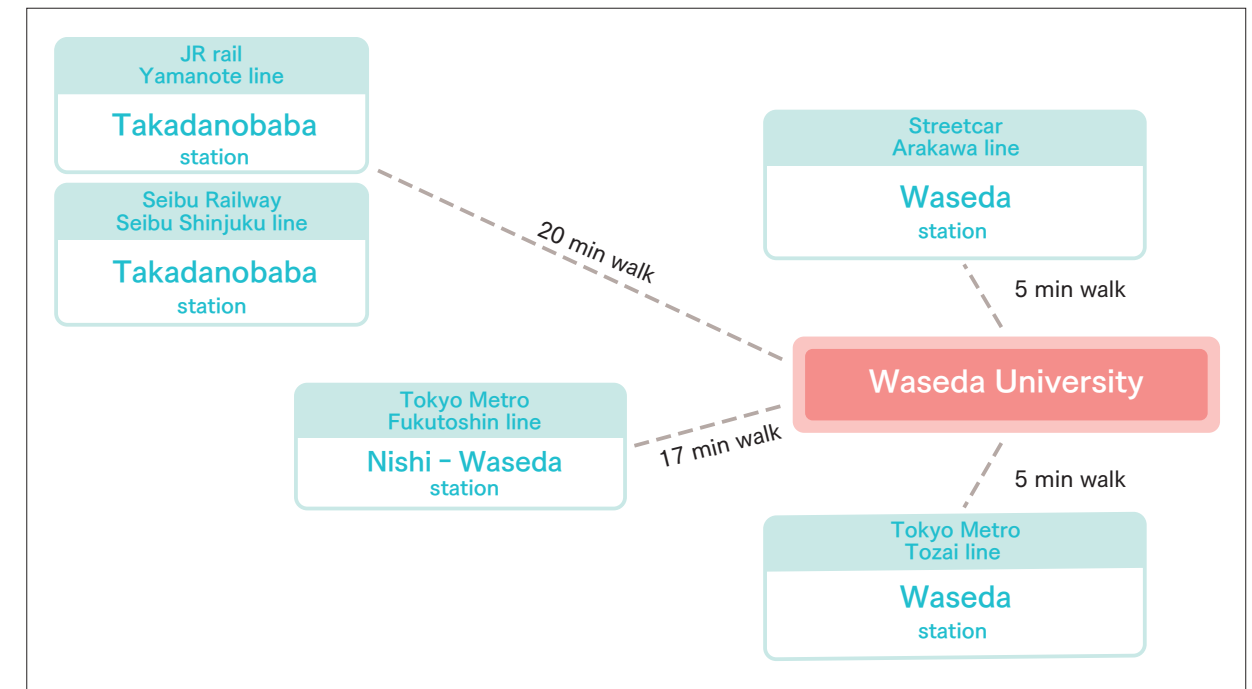
First of all, the shamisen can be classified into three main types according to the thickness of the neck. There are futozao, chuzao and hosozao. The type of music played depends on the thickness of the neck. The Tsugaru shamisen is classified as the futozao type, and is played with a thick, heavy plectrum. The Tsugaru shamisen was originally created as a performing art for male hearing-impaired people called “bosama,” and gradually developed into a stage performance. Today, many Tsugaru shamisen players are struggling to find a new style of Tsugaru shamisen, collaborating not only with traditional folk songs, but also with rock and pop music.

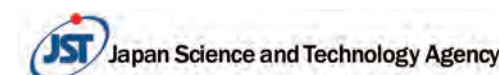
